Moreover, its director and four members of staff have been detained in connection with the boy's death.

Recently I have read Lu Xun's "Wandering" (Pang Huang) again. In "Well Wishes" the first question asked by a woman named as Xianglin when she met Lu Xun was "Do people have any soul after they have died?" Lu Xun replied unexpectedly: It is hard to tell. Lu Xun depicted a painful woman's fate vividly in front of his readers to make them think about what are "Well Wishes". A hundred years have passed. China has become the second largest economy in the world. However, China has moved from the era of 40 million souls suffering a hundred years ago to the era of 1.3 billion people raising their heads proudly today!

Recently a number of parents reported that their children were "brutally treated" by teachers during their rehabilitation training at Changping campus of Senxi Education in Beijing. Beijing Senxi Education is an institute of rehabilitation training targeted mainly at autistic children. Its targets of enrollment are students whose perception and coordinating abilities are poorer, and they are aged between two and six. According to a monitoring video recorded, the teachers involved did not follow the standard procedures during training. Responding to this case, a person in charge of Senxi Education said that "serious mistakes" were really found in the behavior of the teachers involved. Two teachers have been dismissed.

Despite its strong demand, the success rate of IVF for 45-year-old female is around 5%; rather grim in general, medically speaking. In fact, issues on multiple pregnancies or fertility in advanced age have become national. The Reproductive Branch Committee of Chinese Medical Association is therefore, in view of this, undergoing research and discussion on the necessity of drawing a bottom line on the age for pregnancy.
