### Top of the World

The actual sales revenues of the Chinese game market reached RMB 203.61 billion last year, which is 500 million dollars more than the second-placed US. Sales revenues from China’s mobile games market have kept a stunning soar of over RMB 30 billion, showing an increase by 118 times in 10 years. Even the high hoped Chinese film industry, which appears to be successful in the domestic market in recent years, has its sales revenues increased for less than a double in 10 years. In addition, China’s booming online game industry pocketed a handsome export income of over RMB 48 billion last year. It can be said that its overseas sales of game products is far surpassing her other cultural products, making China’s online game industry a major new force in her “going global” movement.

### Gospel to Buyi

Buyi is one of the oldest indigenous tribes in Guizhou. It originates from a branch of the ancient "Baiyue" and shares the same origin with Zhuang. It has a population of about 2.9 million. As early as the early 19th century, Catholic missionaries had already gone to preach the gospel to Buyi. Up to now, it is estimated that about 5,000 Buyi people have returned to the Lord. Recently, Han churches in Central China have had a sense of commitment to the gospel ministry for the ethnic group. They are ready to send believers to go there to live with the Buyi people, to testify Christ and to share the gospel with them.

⌘ Please pray that Buyi people have the opportunities of hearing the gospel. Ask the Lord to use the Chinese Han believers who have recently gone there to live with the Buyi people. Pray that the Lord will help these people so that they can adapt to and respect different culture as soon as possible. Some gifts of unique style gradually went online like hot cakes at the end of Lunar New Year. Some self-made food was packaged as "hand-made" in "home-based workshops" with "mommy's taste" during this period. They penetrated the lives of ordinary people through the online shopping platform. Many merchants adopt "no addition of any preservatives" as the selling point for their self-made food products. But in fact, safety risks are hidden in many self-made food products sold online. Some businessmen have admitted that they do not conduct any food safety inspection in the process of food manufacturing and that the sell-by date is also determined on the basis of experiences. Perhaps some self-made food without three items (i.e. no production date, no certificate of approved quality and no manufacturer) may have had "close contact" with ordinary people's daily life.

### Air for Sale

"How much is a ton of air?" This might seem to be a silly question to the villagers in Aoxi Village of Le'an County, Fuzhou City, Jiangxi Province. More than six months ago, however, the village sold 21,000 tons of carbon dioxide emission reductions to Jiangxi Bank at a price of RMB 15 per ton in line with the carbon sequestration project. The bank said it is their corporate responsibility to purchase an amount of carbon dioxide emission reductions to offset their carbon emissions from holding large-scale activities. For Jiangxi government, "selling air" might perhaps be a new direction in materializing their development of the green. Fu Jiake, Chief Engineer of Fuzhou Forestry Bureau, introduced that some enterprises have adopted schemes of afforestation while others, five counties in Fuzhou, have undergone carbon sink project producing an availability of 163.2 hectares of cooperative woodland.
