### E-cigarette Supervision

Currently the National Health Commission is working with relevant departments to conduct research on e-cigarette supervision. It plans to supervise e-cigarettes through legislation in order to reduce new smokers and people’s exposure to e-cigarettes. China is the world’s largest manufacturing base of e-cigarettes. The e-cigarette production in Shenzhen accounts for about 90% of the overall global production. At this critical time when most countries in the world begin to strengthen supervision of e-cigarettes, China’s supervision of e-cigarettes is gradually progressing. Shenzhen has definitely included e-cigarettes in tobacco control since October 1. Penalties will be directly imposed for personal illegal smoking. Apart from Shenzhen, Hangzhou, Chengdu, Qinhuangdao, Zhangjiakou and other places have also included e-cigarettes in their scope of tobacco supervision.

### Drought Resistance in Jiangxi

The continuous low-rain has caused drought in many towns in Poyang County. Among them is Houjiagang Township at which its high terrain in a mountainous area has caused 53 out of the 59 small type II reservoirs in the township to dry up. The supply of villagers' living water is also affected. From late July to early October, the average rainfall in Jiangxi Province was 96 mm, which was about 70% less than the average. It was the lowest in the history of the same period. The continuous low rainfall caused the water level of the main rivers in Jiangxi Province to decline. Due to the lack of water sources for irrigation, rice fields in some places have been cracked and whitened. In face of the current drought, various measures have been taken in Jiangxi to actively organize the masses to carry out drought relief for self-rescue, striving to minimize the losses caused by the drought.

### Overpass Collapse

The collapse of an overpass on October 10 on Xigang Road, 312 National Road, Wuxi, Jiangsu, has caused three deaths including a mother and daughter: mother 31 years old, daughter only five years old, and a man from Sichuan; two others were injured. A preliminary investigation suggested that the collapse was caused by two excessively overloaded vehicles: The first truck which was carrying six piles of steel coils, weighted a total of 176 tons while the latter truck was with seven piles weighted a total of 183 tons. The reason why these heavily overloaded were on the overpass is still uncertain despite that incidents of overpass collapse has not been infrequent in recent years. In fact, the overpass concerned was assessed as structurally sound by the Wuxi Traffic Engineering Quality Supervision Station.

These fast-moving scooters are like ghost fires glowing in the dark. This kind of scooters are illegally modified and those who are riding them are mostly left-behind children aged between 10 and 18. They dropped out of school and work after their junior high level. Therefore, playing "Ghost-fire" became their only exit of boredom. Without any driver's license nor riding on any licensed motor vehicle, their acts seriously affect the road safety. Recently, the traffic police launched a "squatting action" to rectify serious traffic violations among which "Ghost-fire" is their major concern.
