### Hotel Collapsed

Xinjia Express Hotel in Licheng District of Quanzhou suddenly collapsed on March 7. It was like a place razed to the ground. After the outbreak of the Covid-19, the hotel was being modified to a district-level medical observation venue in Licheng District. It would be used to quarantine and observe people who had close contact with the infected. The collapse occurred during the modification of a unit there. Further investigation is still needed to discern whether the collapse is due to the modification or its original structural problem. So far 71 persons have been rescued from being trapped at the scene and 29 persons killed. Among the killed, 27 persons have no vital signs when they are rescued and two are cases of rescue invalid death. The search and rescue operation has ended.

### Kham Tibetans

Tibetan is habitually divided into three parts according to the dialects: Wei Cang, Kham and Amdo. Kham people are called "Tibetan Cossacks" because they are brave and good at battling; they are called "Tibetan Jews" because they are good at running businesses; and they are also called "Tibetan Gypsies" because they are free and uninhibited. Kham people are devoted to Lamaism. In the mid-19th century, Catholic monks preached to them. Christian ministries also began in 1897. ### Garbage Truck for Meat

On 11 March, a management committee of a Wuhan residential community was found to use garbage trucks to transport the purchased cheap frozen meat to residents. Such move had certainly violated the hygiene standards for food delivery. After the report of the incident on the Internet, it caused viral concern. The management committee apologized to the residents through Weibo and claimed that they would go door-to-door to retrieve their meat for centralized disposal. The committee would also check about its accountability and that the same amount of meat would be delivered to the doorsteps of those involved safely and cleanly the next day. Subsequently, when a number of online photos were exposed, the fact of “garbage trucks carrying meat and vegetables” was suspected to have practiced in multiple communities.

### School Commencement

After the recommencement of schools in Qinghai on March 9, other parts across the country are welcoming their students back as the numbers of new daily COVID-19 confirmed cases have dropped to zero over a consecutive of 20 days. On March 16th, the senior and junior high school students in both Guizhou and Xinjiang held their commencement ceremony. The schools have undertaken a great deal of preparation work for this reopening. There are temperature checks at the school entrance and designated routes for students from different classes lest they interact or mix with others. The schools are in fully closed management. Small class teaching: each class is with their tailor-made time schedule to start and finish classes; each class is with an assigned period for meals within which everyone has an assigned seat to keep them eating apart from the rest. ### Online Class Scams

During the epidemic, the education department required localities to “online all the offline courses” for the sake of “suspending classes without suspending learning”. Schools and educational institutions across the country thus adopted online teaching, that unfortunately opening up a new avenue from which criminals can profit. Some criminals searched for the keyword “parent group” through QQ and WeChat groups, and lurked into the class group as students’ parents. Then they changed their nicknames and avatars to disguise as the teacher of their children and cheated these parents by posting excuses such as “payment for tuition fees” and “payment for materials fees”. At present, department of public security in Jiangsu have filed 60 crimes related to fraud with online courses, of which 256 victims and an amount to more than 370,000 yuan were involved.

### Overseas Virus to Beijing

The WHO announced that the epidemic has now become a global pandemic. Overseas imported cases have become the mainstream of newly confirmed cases in Beijing and they made substantial threats against epidemic prevention and control to the place. Some immigrants arrived in Beijing asymptomatic and were diagnosed only a few days later. In order to further prevent the risk of overseas epidemic import, Beijing imposes new quarantine rules from 00:00 on March 16, that everyone returning to Beijing would be required to isolate themselves for 14 days for centralized observation at their own expense. Only under special circumstances, home quarantine can be conducted after initial screening and surveillance for virus. There are medical healthcare specialists and working staff at these centralized observation points to conduct regularly health monitoring jobs. If problems are found, the related person will be dealt with in a timely manner to secure a better healthcare.
