On June 4, a fifth grader of an elementary school ran out of the classroom and jumped to her death shortly after a writing class. The teacher even slapped the child in the face last year because she would not attend her teacher's self-run private classes. Parents said that their daughter's composition was returned for correction repeatedly, and most of the writing content was circled in red, or simply crossed out. The child was eventually criticized for being too negative. It was questioned if something is wrong with the current teaching methods. But the teacher involved calmly explained that the markings were indeed made by the student herself.

## **Tank Truck Explosion**

At 16:00 on June 13, a gas tanker which was traveling between Ningbo and Wenzhou exploded on Shenhai Expressway at the exit ramp in Wenling, Taizhou, Zhejiang province. A second explosion also occurred after the damaged truck was propelled onto a factory building near to the highway. As of June 15, at least 20 people died and 171 were hospitalized, amongst which 24 were seriously injured. Some people in the collapsed house were trapped and lost contact while buildings surrounded were damaged to varying degrees. In the explosion, a senior three student was killed. The accident occurred less than two hours he arrived home. His home was damaged, and he died after rescue attempt. The large-scale on-site search and rescue has basically completed, while follow-up search and rescue and various aftercare work is taking place.

# **Beijing Epidemic**

Beijing, where its report for COVID-19 has been guiescent for more than 50 consecutive days, shot up to a total of 79 new confirmed cases since June 11. Majority of the cases have been linked to the sprawling Xinfadi Wholesale Market. Compared with the epidemic situation in the Huanan Seafood Wholesale Market in Wuhan, more than 70 cases were detected in Beijing's new site within two days, indicating that the virus is more pathogenic and virulent than Wuhan's. On June 14, the Beijing Municipal Education Commission reported that students who have resumed their classes at school could now opt for studying from home. Whereas the third graders of junior high school can end their semester earlier. Beijing barred people from gathering for meals or holding wedding banquets. All communities in Beijing have resumed their secondary level of epidemic prevention and control.

### Floods

Heavy rain continues to impact provinces in the south. A day's downpour in Guangxi was more than half a year's rainfall of Beijing, causing 148 rivers to exceed the alarm level of flooding. As of June 13, 24 provinces including Guangxi, Guangdong, Hunan, Jiangxi, Guizhou, and Chongqing were particularly impacted: 7.759 million people affected, 63 people died or missing, more than 7,000 houses destroyed, 0.488 million people needed urgent resettlement, plus a direct economic loss of RMB19.58 billion. The number of casualties caused by flash floods accounted for about 70% of the total deaths caused by flooding. June to August is the most critical period for flood control. The meteorological department predicts that the precipitation patterns in China this year will be more north-south and less in the middle: and more flood than drought will be occurred overall.
