Housing Problem

High property prices in cities makes it difficult for young people to find affordable accommodation. In the Central Economic Work Conference held earlier, plans were made for the development of the rental housing market with a view to solving the housing problem. Measures to be carried out include speeding up the construction of social security so that poor families and citizens without housing will be benefited; and accelerating the improvement of the long-term leasing policy to put the rental market in order and regulate the rental level. The authority will increase land supply by looking into the feasibility of using lands designated for mass construction, as well as idle lands owned by enterprises and corporations to build rental housing.

Doing my best does not earn the least respect. Is it true that being a Christian, I cannot divorce even if I am living in pain all the time?”

Being in Debt to Dongxiang

With a population of over 600,000, the Dongxiang ethnic group is the fourth largest community among the Muslim in China. They mainly lived in the Dongxiang Autonomous County in Gansu. The ratio of illiterate population of people aged 15 or above in the Dongxiang group is highest out of all the ethnic minority groups in China. The adult illiteracy rate is still as high as 48%. Although there are missionaries sharing the gospel and actively translating the Bible, the number of people converted to the Christian is still very few. The nearby church of the Han people does not even believe that preaching the gospel to them is feasible.

✂ When we think of the Dongxiang people, we regret that we owe them the debt of the gospel. Pray that the Lord will give us faith and ability to plan how to co-operate with the Dongxiang believers in using the Dongxiang dialect to tell Bible stories. As for ethnic groups with a high rate of illiteracy, using the medium of audio gospel is appropriate. Pray that the Lord will give us the wisdom to help the co-workers to put the ideas into practice and effectively preach the good news of salvation so that non-believers can be converted. Pray also that the Lord will guide the few believers to pursue spiritual growth even under pressure.

“I have believed in God since my childhood. I'm now 27 years old, but I still cannot feel God's love. The gap between teachings and real experiences of God is great. China Youth Daily has conducted a survey of more than 2,000 respondents through a questionnaire network. More than 60% of the respondents mind the age-related labels. The reasons include the influences of these labels on social interaction, workplace, dating and marriage. They also affect some people's social image and self-perception. By comparing, it is found that those born in the 90s are the group who cares most the age-related labels, and that nearly 70% of the respondents have replied that they mind.

Tactics to Lift out of Poverty

Shanxi is one of the poor provinces in China. The local government has taken corresponding measures; such as provide training for people to increase their employment opportunities. During the epidemic, the government have also contacted employment units in other regions to collect information on job vacancies, and then provided referral services and even point-to-point special vehicles to help workers go out for work. In the New Year's Day, Shanxi has organized services involving more than 11,000 exported labors. Their job locations including Beijing, Zhejiang, Jiangsu, Guangdong, Shaanxi and Shandong.

Alarming Privacy Leakage

A doctor in Hangzhou was sentenced to five days' administrative detention for deliberately leaking a patient's privacy. The identity information and contact number of an asymptomatic infected person who was diagnosed with COVID-19 were widely spread via the Internet. After investigation, it was discovered that the doctor involved had forwarded the relevant report to a WeChat group. The leakage incident also let the other two people to take the opportunity to spread rumors. They were sentenced to administrative detention for seven days. This is not the first time a similar case has occurred in China. In the era of big data, how to ensure the security of personal information has become a social topic of public concern.
