### Where is My Money?

Concerns have been raised over the incidents of people unable to withdraw their savings from rural banks in Henan Province in the past few months. The Provincial Public Security Bureau reported that criminal gangs had taken control of the local banks by transferring the funds through illegal means such as virtual loans, and deleting data, screening and concealing facts. The case is still under investigation. The Henan Banking and Insurance Regulatory Commission and the Local Financial Supervision Bureau of Henan Province issued an announcement that they would make advance payment of principal to off-book business customers of the four rural banks by classification and in batches according to the investigation of the case and the recovery of funds and assets. The first batch will be the customers with a combined amount of less than RMB 50,000 for a single institution and a single person.

### Hard to Get Hired

Notes like "Those who have been admitted to mobile cabin hospital or diagnosed positive in Covid-19 will not be employed!" appeared on job advertisements in China. Criticism arises as this would impose obstacles for Covid-19 rehabilitators when applying for jobs. For example, some companies would ask applicants to show their nucleic acid test records of the past two months. Once the company spots a positive diagnosis, the applicant will be rejected. In accordance with China's Employment Promotion Law and the Law on Prevention and Treatment of Infectious Diseases, it states clearly that no unit or person shall discriminate against infectious disease patients, pathogen carriers or suspected infectious disease patients. To effectively curb employment discrimination, some legal personnel pointed out that the privacy of health codes needs to be better managed and strengthened to avoid easy disclosure of personal medical information.

The Chinese Population Research Unit proposed the trend of population change in China. It points out that during the medium and long term of the "14th Five-Year Plan" period (2021-2025), the total population will experience a zero growth and a negative growth, respectively. By 2035 and beyond, a drop to about ten million of China's annual birth population will be predicted. Moreover, China's elderly population will increase by 50% to more than double in the next decade. The population over the age of sixty will increase from 264 million in 2020 to 400 million in 2032 while the number of over-eighties will double from 35.7 million in 2020 to 79.6 million.
