At the First Session of the 14th National Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (CPPCC) held earlier, President Xi Jinping stated at the joint meeting of Civil Construction, Industry and Commerce Federation that it was necessary to optimize the development environment of private enterprises: remove institutional obstacles that restrict private enterprises from participating in market competition fairly; protect the property rights of private enterprises in accordance with the law; encourage and support the development and growth of the private economy and enterprises; guide private enterprises and entrepreneurs to correctly understand the target and policies of the government so as to put forth more effective measures for a healthy and high-quality development of the private economy.



Do Good Deeds

There is a non-governmental emergency rescue motorcade in Taiyuan, Shanxi Province. The team members respond to every request and provide emergency rescue services for free on roads, including restoration of car batteries, tire inflation and tire replacement for vehicles. So far, it has completed more than 11,000 rescue cases. There are 27 team members at the beginning and they have grown to 87. Some of the team members, who are beneficiaries initially, have become volunteers. The founder of the motorcade said that he hoped to inspire more people to do good deeds. He said the next step was to develop an emergency rescue alliance for various places and cities across the province.

Pet Food Safety

The China Consumers Association has recently released data showing that 6.617 cases of complaints involving pets were received in the first half of 2022. The major problem in the cases is related to pet food safety. Although there are relevant national standards for pet food, they are not enforced compulsorily. It is found that some unscrupulous manufacturers sell pet food online by mixing the genuine with the fake products. For example, the raw materials are mixed even with soil and wood chips that will cause sickness to pets. In one case, a consumer had contacted an online shop due to the problem with the pet food he had bought. He requested for a refund and compensations for the costs of medical treatment for his pet. But the case was left unsettled in the end because the pet's illness could not be proved to be related to the pet food consumed.

An evening school in Kunming has specially started a "new citizen lesson" in order to help the workers adapt to urban life. In addition, some companies have set up service stations to provide the workers with voluntary services such as provision of travel guidebooks, consultation about medical services and legal assistance.
