Wedding Customs Reform

In China, especially in rural areas, the older generation believes that marriage is an important social ritual that is closely related to family's dignity. In order to gain recognition, they pay close attention to the amount of dowry and the size of the wedding. However, young people who have returned to their hometowns from the cities to start their own businesses are willing to break with tradition, adopting new and simplified wedding customs. Currently, local governments across the country are also promoting wedding customs reform, advocating for simple and moderate, green and low-carbon ways of celebrating weddings. These include holding collective weddings, family weddings, and destination weddings, participating in social welfare activities, planting commemorative trees as a couple, etc. These methods not only reduce the economic burden but also do not lose their meaning. "Young people choose to offer incense rather than advance in their careers." According to report from travel websites, bookings for temple-related scenic spots have increased more than threefold since the beginning of this year. Since February, the 90s and 00s generation has accounted for more than half of the ticket bookings. An article in the New Beijing News on March 21 criticized young people for "not attending classes, not selfenhancing, but only offering incense," suggesting that if young people place their hope in gods and Buddhas, they are clearly "going astray."

Many Chinese people look to money as the direction of their lives. They used to believe in "working hard is better than relying on heaven and earth," firmly believing that hard work can lead to wealth. However, as the economic structure solidifies and economic growth slows down, when young people enter the workplace, they find that the path they believed in of working hard to get rich has not brought them the expected wealth, and they become confused and lost. AI Diagnosis

Last month the "5G Smart Patrol Vehicle of Ophthalmology" invented by a university's scientific research team was officially launched. The first batch of three patrol vehicles is equipped with AI doctors. They can complete a series of eye examinations in just ten minutes and regularly visit different cities in China. They also go to schools, nursing homes for the aged and communities providing professional eye health assessment. People seeking consultation are only required to make an appointment online and undergo their examination on the vehicles. The initial screening can be completed by the AI system. If eye problems are found, it will be reported immediately.

Car-hailing In Trouble

The online car-hailing industry is close to saturation and the rate of empty orders is rising. Various places have issued notices one after another to suspend more new operators. Cities such as Zhuhai, Jinan, Suining, Changsha, and Sanya have successively issued notices on risk warnings for the online car rental industry since the beginning of this year. At the same time, drivers and passengers of online booked cars face contradictions. Some drivers say that they cannot receive orders even after waiting hard. They do not even go home until early in the morning in order to gain enough orders. But some passengers, on the other hand, feel that they often cannot book a car. It is common to find no driver accepting an online car-hailing order for half an hour especially during the peak travel period.

Green Great Wall

Chinese President Xi Jinping said earlier in Inner Mongolia that despite improvements in desertification, the problem remains unresolved. Moreover, China has been affected by the abnormal climatic changes for the past two years and the number of sandstorms in the north has increased. The "Three-North" project must be continued to build green ecological barriers which can resist wind and sand, maintain water and soil, and protect and promote husbandry. The project, which has been launched since 1978, refers to the construction of large-scale forest belts in Northwest China, North China and Northeast China. The total area is 4.358 million square kilometers, accounting for 45% of the total national area. It is called the "Green Great Wall".
