Scammers are posting fake welfare offers on video platforms to lure victims. They then request the victim's WeChat login details, claiming they need the account for "tasks" and even advise transferring money out of the WeChat wallet first to gain trust. Next, they ask the victim to change the password to a specified one and log out, pretending they only need the account to boost sales and reviews. If the victim complies, the scammer takes over the account and sells it to criminals. Most victims are minors who lack the knowledge to recover their accounts.

## The Voice of the Bai People

Missionary Yang Zhiying, former supervisor of China Inland Mission in western Yunnan, noted: "Unless the gospel is shared in the Bai dialect, the mission cannot reach its full potential." The Bai people, numbering about 1.85 million, mainly live in Yunnan, with smaller groups in Guizhou and Hunan. Buddhism and Daoism arrived early, but their traditional faith centers on local deities. The Bai are generally well-educated but face great challenges such as family breakdown and divorce due to urbanization. Through years of missionary effort, there are now around 50,000 Bai Christians. The New Testament has been translated and recorded in their own dialect, but the audio Bible is not yet available online.

- ✠ We thank the Lord for Bai believers who record and share biblical truths and teachings on marriage and family in their heart language. Now, the Bai have access to the New Testament in audio! May God continue to bless and strengthen these efforts.

Dear Warriors in Christ,

*"Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season." (2 Timothy 4:2, NIV)*

This was among Paul's final charges to Timothy. The original text conveys a command: "You must preach!" "Be prepared" can also be translated as "be ready (NASB)", "be urgent (ASV)" or "be instant (KJV)." Paul called Timothy to be ready at all times, never ceasing to testify of God.

When I reflect on "be prepared," I picture firefighters—when the alarm rings, they must be equipped and out the door ASAP. Their urgency and readiness mirror the attitude Paul urged: a sense of pressing urgency to act.

Such urgency does not come from expecting great results. In fact, Paul warned, *"People will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers..." (4:3-4).* Yet Paul charged Timothy, *"But you, keep your head in all situations... fulfill your ministry." (4:5)* This was Timothy's calling—passing on the gospel as Paul had done.

In the early days of the Gospel broadcast ministry, feedback from listeners was limited. Co-workers silently persevered and held fast to God's trust because this was the task assigned to FEBC. Through generations of unwavering efforts, we continue to witness God through audio ministry with the same "urgency" and "diligence." At the same time, we also need your continuous prayers—for us and for the listeners!

There was a decrease in the number of harassing phone calls upon the CCTV report about the agencies using AI systems making the calls. Recently people stated that AI harassment calls increased again. AI caller claimed that the listener had inquired about the price of dental implants and introduced some promotion plans. The call would be directed to a human staff if the listener was interested in the plans. According to the industry, you can start automating phone calls with AI after purchasing the platform software and hardware. Call center lines, in fact, are not allowed to be used for cold call marketing. Since there is lack of regulation and the profits obtained by committing the crime are higher than the fines imposed, AI calls cannot be stopped.

## Illegal Pirated Recording

The Dongyang City Public Security Bureau in Zhejiang Province cracked a criminal case of pirated recording and illegal distribution of Spring Festival blockbusters. Individuals were detained on suspicion of illegally distributing pirated versions of a number of popular films, including “Ne Zha 2” and “Detective Chinatown 1900”. Seven suspects have been arrested. More than 130 websites and 200,000 infringing copies of films worth more than RMB 25 million are involved. The Bureau will subsequently work with the relevant departments to step up online monitoring by focusing on the characteristics of copyright infringement crimes, and increase awareness of and the ability to combat piracy.
