Recently, a product called "Children's Fingerprint-bottle" has sparked discussions online. However, investigations reveal that these so-called "high-tech" bottles often malfunction: fingerprint locks fail to open, batteries refuse to charge, and warranty services are poor. Long-term use also raises concerns with cleaning, leaks, and potential electrical hazards. What was meant to protect children often ends up being more troublesome instead.

## Unfinished Elevator Installation

Installation of elevators in old buildings can easily cost hundreds of thousands, or even millions of dollars (RMB). A reporter has discovered that elevator installation projects have been left unfinished in some small communities and that some projects have been delayed for over two years. Some residents of small communities have endured a seven-year waiting period but their hope for elevator installation still cannot come true. Some property owners have attempted to pursue the elevator company through the court. But their cases cannot be filed for investigation ultimately because filing of these cases requires unanimous consent from all owners who need to submit litigation materials to the court jointly. So the threshold is high.

## Forced To Be Labor

A reporter has conducted undercover investigations into brick factories in Hunan Province. It is discovered that mentally retarded people are forced to work as labor and that their wages are embezzled by the foremen. It is found that there are mentally retarded people working as labor in at least 50 brick factories over the past decade. Nearly 400 people have been forced to become labor. They are either lured or purchased on streets and they become “tools” for making profits. Operators of many brick factories have outsourced the work due to the difficulties of recruiting workers. They believe that after the work has been outsourced, their brick factories will not be involved in the cases.

## Pop-up Advertisements

Netizens note that App pop-up ads have countdowns of 18 seconds, but the actual viewing durations are over 30 seconds. Recently a reporter has tested 50 common Apps and found problems existing in the pop-up ads among over half of these Apps. Some pop-up ads automatically redirect to other Apps upon opening. Some of them disguise themselves as system notifications while others even have pop up ads on top of existing ads. Although the Advertising Law stipulates “one-click closure,” there is a lack of detailed regulations or unified standards governing the accuracy and authenticity of the actual advertisement playback duration.
