Respite Care for the Elderly

During the National Day and Mid-Autumn Festival holidays, a Hangzhou sub-district partnered with local institutions to launch the pilot "Respite Care for the Elderly" service. For RMB 99 per day, elderly residents can stay at a care center. Traditional care homes primarily focus on long-term care, failing to meet short-term needs. Day care services provide daily assistance, they do not offer overnight stays and often have staff shortages during holidays. Experts suggest that popularizing respite care services requires standardizing the services, fee regulations and oversight mechanisms to ensure service quality. Hope that the authorities will encourage greater participation through subsidies and tax incentives.

Dear Warriors in Christ,

The Corinthian church formed factions in support of their chosen pastors. To this, Paul responded plainly: "*What, after all, is Apollos? And what is Paul? Only servants, through whom you came to believe—as the Lord has assigned to each his task.*" (1 Cor. 3:5) Both Paul and Apollos understood that they belonged to Christ and worked for God.

Apollos appears only a few times in the Bible. He is a believer when first appears (1 Cor. 18:24-28). A scholar with the ability to expound, he began sharing his faith with others. Yet the Scriptures describe him as knowing only the baptism of John (1 Cor. 18:25). At that time, the couple Priscilla and Aquila, Paul's fellow workers, explained the word of God to him in detail. Apollos, being discerning and highly educated, was not in distress hearing others' criticisms. He humbly expressed gratitude for the teaching and believed that it was for the sake of spreading Jesus' teachings in a pure and accurate way.

Humility is a virtue that may seem diminished in modern society but remains essential for personal and social well-being. Jesus declared Himself gentle and humble (Mat. 11:29), and Paul likewise described himself as humble (2 Cor. 10:1). Could we humble ourselves? In ministry, humility helps us avoid unnecessary strife. By listening to others, we can learn to identify our own weaknesses and blind spots. Listening to different perspectives, we can gain a broader understanding of how others approach situations and seek a workable solution. Since we are called to follow the example and imitate the virtues of God and His saints, let us practice humility diligently.

Fake Homeroom Teacher

Police recently investigated a case in which a scammer impersonated a middle school homeroom teacher, stealing his profile photo and nickname to post false payment requests in the school’s official class chat group. The message included a QR code for fee payment, which some parents paid without verification. Although the real teacher quickly alerted the group, seven parents were deceived, each losing RMB 88 dollars. The suspect later confessed that they had bought multiple QQ accounts, searched for class chat groups online, joined them by pretending to be parents, and then carried out the fraud.

New Competition Law

The newly revised “Anti-Unfair Competition Law of the People’s Republic of China” took effect on October 15. It explicitly prohibits businesses from using data, algorithms, or platform rules to: (1) disrupt competitors’ services through forced redirects or malicious uninstalls; (2) improperly obtain or use others’ legally held data; or, (3) abuse platform rules to suppress rivals through fake transactions, reviews, or returns. The amendment also targets the issue of large enterprises delaying payments to small and medium-sized firms, aiming to foster fairer competition and provide a clearer legal basis for protecting their rights.

AI Facade

Recently, some netizens reported that some restaurants on delivery apps were using fake “AI-enhanced” storefront photos. Consumers were caught off guard. Listings showed spacious dining rooms with bright signs and crowds, but the actual locations were tiny street kitchens. Reporters found that online vendors offer custom AI-generated “storefront design” images for as little as RMB 10, allowing eateries to post fake photos easily to mislead customers.

Illegal Expedition

On October 5, authorities in Gansu responded to an emergency report: a number of mountain climbers had illegally entered the Lenglongling region of the Qilian Mountains and got stranded in an alpine region near Laohugou in Menyuan County. The unmarked route sits above 4,000 meters, posing extreme danger due to unpredictable weather and complex terrain. Some climbers carried unsuitable gear for high altitude and icy weather. Rescuers faced challenges due to rain and snow with some areas inaccessible by vehicles, requiring difficult on-foot rescue efforts. By noon on the 7th, both the north and south rescue teams finally met and the rescue was completed. Of the 251 rescued, one person died from altitude sickness and hypothermia.
