Recently, discussions about "AI flattery" have surged. Some praise AI's gentle narration and praising interaction; others are uncomfortable with this expression, believing that excessive flattery and pandering to users can affect their own judgment. The report points out that many AI chat products were designed from the outset with the goal of "extending user engagement." To achieve this, AI constantly analyzes the user's tone, tending to provide "comfortable" responses. Experts believe that it is crucial to help the public retain necessary skepticism and reflective abilities when using AI, avoiding the unconscious surrender of judgment to the technological system in long-term interactions.

A Hui Christian from the Northwest region shared guidance for gospeling them, suggesting not to interfere with their customs, acknowledging their "God" as the Creator, but comparing the Bible and the Quran, Jesus and Muhammad to help them understand the truth, identifying deviations in their faith, and guiding them on the truth. However, because they possess a sense of superiority, it is neither advisable nor necessary to debate with them.

Dear Warriors in Christ,

"I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will look forth to see what he will speak with me, and what I shall answer concerning my complaint." (Hab. 2:1) Watchtowers and towers were the highest points on ancient city walls, used to observe distant movements and defend against enemy attacks. The prophet's choice to "stand in his watchtower and on its tower" to observe:

First, he "actively waited." The prophet consciously ascended to a high place, adjusting his position to listen more clearly to God's voice. This waiting was not passive surrender, but active preparation.

Second, he "observed attentively." The prophet's eyes were focused on the will God was about to reveal, not on the surrounding chaos.

Third, this was an "open stance." He prepared his heart not only to "hear" God's word, but also to continue to converse with God honestly, not concealing his grievances before Him.

The prophet posed painful questions to God, and although God's response did not completely resolve his confusion, the prophet continued to come before God with humility and trust.

Have you ever lost your zeal and faith in prayer because of delayed answers and unresolved suffering? In times of global turmoil and shattered faith, can we learn from the prophets and continue to fix our eyes on the eternal?

At this moment, may you find your own "watchtower" and hear that small voice there—He never fails, and His promises will surely be fulfilled.

Mechanical Handles

The Ministry of Industry and Information Technology has released a new mandatory national standard “Safety Technical Requirements for Automobile Door Handles” which is scheduled to take effect on 1 January 2027. The standard aims to address key issues such as the drawbacks of interior door handles, failure to open doors after accidents, poor operability of interior door handles, and malfunctions in certain scenarios. The standard stipulates that exterior and interior door handles must have an independent mechanical release device. There were extreme incidents that the handles failed to operate when the vehicles ran out of power. Automakers will be granted a transition period up to 25 months with the final deadline set on 1 January 2029.”

The Procuratorate stipulates that any video content intended to obtain direct or indirect commercial benefits, oriented towards recommending or selling goods or services, and established in a cooperative relationship with the operator shall be labeled an advertisement.
