Domestic robots that act as assistants feature more than 30 functions such as interactive entertainment, health monitoring, answering calls. Dear Warriors in Christ,

According to John 11, Jesus was determined to go to the dangerous Judea raising Lazarus from the dead and Thomas failed to dissuade him but could only said, "Let us go along that we may die with him." Relationship between Jesus and his disciples was fundamentally based on experiencing life together — a relational and practical apprenticeship.

The relationship between Radio Liangyou and our audience is sometimes akin to a spiritual companionship that resembles a mentor-disciple bond. Though we have never met in person, audience will open up their inner mind when listening to us. Every word and action of the hosts serve as a model for following Christ, can be a transformative experience for audience getting through difficult times in a "virtual yet real" companion.

The theological concept of "dying together" with Christ signifies Christ's willingness to humble Himself instead of our good words. Similarly, audience's loyalty is built on vulnerability rather than perfection. The key is the hosts' willingness to first draw near to the audience's suffering. Broadcasting functions as a form of incarnation. Jesus also wept, and had people He loved. Gospel broadcasting is not about "what we have done", but "who we are", focusing on bringing people to God through our weaknesses, demonstrating the glory of the Son of God.

Online “Doxxing”

“Doxxing” is an escalated form of what was once called “human flesh search” — the illegal obtaining and public release of a person's private information, often inciting others to harass and abuse the victim. Recently, a social media influencer became the target of online doxxing. She was flooded with harassment messages, and some even posted threats in her livestream comments. The harassment made normal life impossible for both her and her family. Police later arrested suspects involved in the case. They admitted that they had purchased the influencer's personal information online and reposted it. After trial, the court ordered the defendants to make a public apology through national media and to pay RMB 100,000 in compensation for public welfare damages.

Mobile Roadblocks

On highways, vehicles driving at a “snail's pace” have become a primary cause of prolonged travel times and severe traffic jams. Data from the Ministry of Public Security's Road Traffic Safety Research Center shows that for every 10 km/h drop in speed, road capacity decreases by approximately 15%. During highway traffic jams, nearly half of the bottlenecks are chain reactions triggered by slow-moving vehicles occupying lanes. When the speed differential between vehicles reaches 32 km/h, the probability of an accident increases by roughly 16 times. As traffic management continues to improve, strictly penalizing illegal slow driving has become standard practice. In addition to national penalty rules, some regions have refined their enforcement measures.

Pet Transportation Services

During this year's Spring Festival holiday, demand for pet transportation surged. However, due to low barriers to market entry and a lack of unified service standards, several alarming issues were exposed. These included inconsistent service quality, and severe safety hazards during transit. Some pets were mixed up, left unfed during the journey, or even contracted illnesses and died. Industry insiders note that pet transportation is a newly emerging sector over the past two years, and authorities have yet to issue standard regulations. Consequently, an illegal “black market” for transport exists. Advocates are calling for the government to establish official standards as soon as possible to promote the healthy development of the industry.

Children Online

The issue of minors becoming addicted to the internet and being exposed to harmful information is drawing widespread concern. During China's annual parliamentary meetings (the “Two Sessions”), multiple delegates suggested tackling the issue through legal frameworks, enforcing platform accountability, and weaving a tighter protective net. Data shows that mainland China now has 1.123 billion internet users, with nearly 200 million being minors, and the age at which children first go online is dropping. Delegates also called for values-based content guidelines, viewing-time restrictions, and tighter controls on pop-up advertising — all as part of a comprehensive, society-wide framework to protect young people online.
