### Prices Rise Every Holiday

During May Day holiday, domestic travel continued to surge, driving a year-on-year increase of 18% in hotel accommodation spending. Many consumers reported that the price hikes for holiday hotel accommodation were "excessively outrageous." Since March, relevant authorities have issued a series of warning letters regarding the maintenance of stable hotel prices during the May Day period. Experts note that these letters typically focus only on the penalties for price gouging without actually defining the act itself. For hotels, raising the price of a single room by a few hundred can yield substantial profits in just a few days. Compared to the probability of being investigated and the potential fines, this is enough to tempt many operators to take the risk.

### Workplace Surveillance

As AI technology evolves, some companies have begun implementing "digital surveillance" to manage employees through smart video surveillance, computer browsing-record monitoring, and real-time location tracking of work phones, etc. Experts comment that the purpose of digital surveillance must be legitimate, such as ensuring office safety, enforcing work discipline, protecting trade secrets, and the scope of such monitoring should be limited to public areas of the workplace. Employee monitoring should be confined within working hours covering only work-related activities. Employees' private chats and personal files, etc. must not be monitored, and employees must be informed of what is being monitored and their explicit consent must be obtained.

### Fraudulent Shipment

Recently, netizens have posted online claiming that when orders are placed via the same link by the same user on e-commerce platforms, the quality of products that delivered to different addresses varies drastically with higher-quality items sent to Bei-Shang-Guang-Shen and lower-quality items sent to lower-tier cities. Such "AB goods" aim to attract customers by high-quality products and profit from the price difference of substandard goods while passing operating costs onto consumers. The recent phenomenon of "geographically-targeted AB goods" represents unreasonable differential treatment of consumers, constitutes consumer discrimination and potentially consumer fraud.

### Illegal Food Delivery Brokers

Shanghai police cracked a case involving the forgery of online food service licenses, dismantling an illicit supply chain involving business recruitment and setup, license processing and profit-making. Nine suspects were arrested. The modus operandi was mainly composed of three factors: First, "Multiple stores with one single address," where some merchants operated only one physical store but sought to illegally open multiple online food-delivery stores; second, "Operating without a physical address," where the gang targeted closed or offline-only stores to steal their business license information; and third, "License tampering," where the gang used photo-editing software to alter the business scope for merchants lacking proper qualifications.

### Handmade Cars

The "handmade car" is actually a four-wheel electric mobility scooter for the elderly. As early as 2018, the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology and five other departments jointly published to impose stricter management on low-speed electric vehicles. Non-standard electric four-wheel cars have been classified as illegal. These "cars" have not undergone any safety testing. However, there is still private ordering as their affordable pricing meets the demands. Since non-standard electric four-wheel cars are banned, merchants sell the parts separately to consumers for their own "assembly". Regulatory authorities should monitor the final destination of the components in order to stop "handmade cars" from reaching the general market.
