A video has shocked netizens by showing a pet dog eagerly licking a cake from its owner’s plate at a hot-pot restaurant. Many netizens stated outright that they found it unacceptable. The restaurant thus announced it would suspend pet services of three of their pet-friendly restaurants. Experts believe that the mall operator should thoroughly consider whether to be pet-friendly, or it will become “pseudo-pet-friendly”. Recently, the China Department Store Commercial Association has officially released the Pet-Friendly Mall Operation Specifications which is the country’s first industry standard for pet-friendly malls providing systematic regulations on venue management, safety and security and related matters.

Gospel Spread in Inner Mongolia

The earliest introduction of Christianity to the Mongol people and the Inner Mongolia region can be traced back to the Yuan Dynasty. Around 1862, Hudson Taylor preached in the village of Sha’erxin on the outskirts of Baotou in Inner Mongolia. Subsequently, missionaries from the Swedish Missionary Society, the Assemblies of God and the China Evangelical Mission went to central and western Inner Mongolia, launching social welfare initiatives. After the founding of the PRC, missionaries started to leave. With several decades of development, the churches in Inner Mongolia flourished for a time. However, various challenges over the past decade have forced some church leaders being scrutinized to move to remote towns with their families and continue their service in a limited environment.

Elderly Care Services

The “15th Five-Year Plan” outline proposes optimizing the supply of basic elderly care services, improving the urban-rural elderly care service network, and promoting the integration of medical and elderly care, long-term care insurance, and a care system for the disabled and those with dementia. The newly released “Opinions on Accelerating the Establishment of a Long-term Care Insurance System” proposes establishing such a system within three years. Reporters have found that rural attitudes toward elderly care remain conservative, with the concept of “working until you drop” being widespread. The phenomena of empty-nest and left-behind elderly are intensifying. Some elderly individuals and their families resist moving into care facilities due to financial pressures and fears of losing social connections.

Rental Traps

The peak season for renting apartments runs from June to August each year. Many renters find a place they like during viewings, but realize after moving in that it is completely different from what was promised. Some apartments are plagued by severe mold—with some even growing mushrooms—while others are newly renovated but have dangerously high levels of toxic formaldehyde. Under the Civil Code, if a rental property threatens the safety or health of the tenant, the tenant has the right to break the lease, even if they knew about the issues before signing. Legal experts advise renters to always use licensed agencies and to double-check the landlord's original ID and property certificates to make sure they are dealing with the actual owner.

Post-Graduation Paths

A report released in Beijing shows that as AI accelerates industrial transformation, and as industrial digitalization and intelligent upgrading continue to advance, market demand remains strong for talents with engineering practice and technological innovation capabilities. The downward shift of industries and rapid technological iteration are causing graduates' employment structure to shift toward advanced manufacturing and modern services. The old trend where everyone blindly rushed into graduate school or insisted on moving to top-tier cities is giving way to more diverse career choices. In 2025, the proportion of graduates employed in prefecture-level cities and below rose to 63%. On the education front, more students are choosing grad school at top 'Double First-Class' universities.

Fake Certificates Trading

Reporters recently found that many online sellers are openly trading professional skill certificates. Some are supposedly issued by legitimate industry associations, yet anyone can buy them for just a few hundred. Even vocational qualifications that should be verifiable on the Ministry of Human Resources and Social Security's official website are being openly sold, complete with cheating and proxy-testing services that guarantee a passing grade. Lawyers point out that this widespread fraud severely damages the credibility of official certifications and industry groups, undermining the whole professional evaluation framework. Experts recommend implementing strict registration rules, monitoring the entire evaluation process, and conducting random spot checks, with immediate closure and legal action for any group caught breaking the rules.
