Centralized Cooling

The heat is unbearable, with the highest temperature in Xuzhou, Jiangsu, exceeding 35°C. Yet the indoor temperature in residential buildings remains below 26°C even without air conditioning. This coolness comes from beneath the floor, where low-temperature water flowing through underfloor heating pipes provides radiant floor cooling. The "coolness" enjoyed by residents in their homes comes from the now-closed Woniushan Coal Mine in the area. Although the mine has been shut down, the water accumulated in the mine shafts remains at around 19°C year-round and flows continuously, serving as a natural "coolant." This system reduces energy consumption by approximately 50%.

We step back and hide ourselves, because the focus is never on the interpreter, but on the speaker and the truth they seek to share.

Interpretation is never walked alone. When working with a partner, we must be in sync and in harmony. Each speaker has unique linguistic habits and speaking speed, so we attune to our partner's rhythm, listen to one another, and take turns—without rushing or falling behind, without cutting in or lagging—finding the right flow through listening and building trust.

One of the best lessons I received was not to fear mistakes. In ministry, mistakes are inevitable: a missed word or an imprecise translation can linger in the mind. Yet if we dwell on the error, it pulls the mind backward like the first domino, affecting everything that follows. How precious is Paul's reminder: "Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead." Entrust yesterday's shortcomings to the Lord, and even today's oversights to Him as well. What matters is not lingering on where we stumbled, but moving forward in grace.

Sold Out in Seconds

Sluggish operation of or tickets being sold out in seconds on the ticketing system for scenic spots have been probably caused by illegal scalper groups. Beijing police detected an overwhelming surge of malicious network requests at the moment tickets go on sale. This case involved a cross-regional, multi-stage and full-chain technical ticket-scalping criminal syndicate engaged in the formulation of ticket-scalping programs and the online promotion of resale. The police launched simultaneous arrest operations across five provinces and municipalities, apprehending ten suspects. The public was reminded to make bookings via official platforms, and should not trust online advertisements offering paid ticket-booking services, so as to protect themselves from financial fraud and information leakage.

Review Spamming

Customer reviews indicate rankings on food review apps are becoming increasingly unreliable. Quite a number of highly-recommended operators are suspected of inflating their business reputation by purchasing fake positive reviews. Beside fake positive reviews, there are also malicious negative reviews. Investigation has revealed that these spamming services operate openly across e-commerce networks with standardized pricing tiers. They are named “professional negative reviewers”. Experts advise that consumers should assess the authenticity of reviews by considering a basket of factors, including the posting time, repetitive content, reviewer history, authentic photo verification and proof of purchase. Cross-referencing such as validated business credentials, regulatory information and reputation across multiple channels is also worth it.

Desert Island Transformation

The Ningbo Coast Guard Bureau in Zhejiang Province officially investigated a case of illegal occupation and modification of an uninhabited island. The incident took place on Qiaomuwang Island, Xiangshan County. The entire process was live-streamed under the title “Desert Island Transformation”. The vlogger was seen building a house on the island and role-playing as a “modern Robinson Crusoe”. Lawyers have pointed out that his act may result in administrative, civil and criminal liability. Administrative authorities may order the cessation of the unlawful conduct. In civil terms, the individual will be liable for compensation for and restoration of the damaged ecological environment. In criminal terms, the offences may include crimes of destroying ecological environment and illegal lodging.

Antibiotics Frogs

Bullfrogs have, in recent years, become a popular dish in dining. Between 2015 and 2024, bullfrog production has grown by 317.6%. Recently, bullfrog samples collected from certain e-commerce platforms were found to contain excessive levels of antibiotics and some samples even tested positive for banned substances. A number of market regulation bureaus sealed the products, collected samples for testing, and also took legal action based on investigation findings. Some individual breeders have practiced high-density farming to boost the growth of bullfrogs by overfeeding. High temperature has also led to a decline in the bullfrogs’ immunity. Experts point out that the use of medication based on experience without scientific guidance, and bypassing withdrawal periods before selling the frogs directly to the market can easily lead to excessive levels of antibiotics in aquatic products.
